<u>Review of Prior Meeting's Minutes:</u> The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Mary Ann Micheletti and seconded by Lynn Burshtin to approve the minutes as presented, and all members present voted in the affirmative.

<u>Old Business</u>: Secretary Randall Knapp reported the scott packs ordered in September 2023, still have an estimated delivery date of December 11, 2023.

A decision should be made by the end of the month for The Leary Foundation Grant application.

The Buena Vista Township Committee approved Resolution 2023-16 regarding the 2024 Commissioner stipends.

<u>New Business:</u> Treasurer Lynn Burshtin reported that as the uniform allowance will be distributed to the Richland Volunteer Fire Company firefighters after November 30, the following resolution was offered:

<u>Resolution 2023-19</u>: (Uniform Allowance) - A motion was made by Lynn Burshtin and seconded by Randall Knapp to authorize the Treasurer to issue Uniform Allowance payments in accordance with the 2023 Budget amount of \$3,900.00, and to authorize the Fire District officers to sign these uniform allowance checks. Roll Call: L. Burshtin - Yes, R. Knapp - Yes, Levari, Jr. - Absent, Levari III - Absent, Micheletti - Yes. Motion was approved.

<u>Resolution 2023-20</u>: (Budget Approval) - A motion was made by Lynn Burshtin and seconded by Mary Ann Micheletti to approve a 2024 annual budget in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law, reflecting total revenues of \$336,984.00 including an amount to be raised by taxation of \$275,925.00 and total appropriations of \$336,984.00 including supplemental schedules, with the 2024 annual budget being considered for adoption at the December 12, 2023 meeting. Roll Call: L. Burshtin - Yes, R. Knapp - Yes, Levari, Jr. - Absent, Levari III - Absent, Micheletti - Yes. Motion was approved. The Secretary will submit the budget package to the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs for their review and approval.

The establishment of the required budget public hearing was discussed:

<u>Resolution 2023-21</u>: (Budget Public Hearing) - A motion was made by Randall Knapp and seconded by Lynn Burshtin to hold a public hearing on the proposed 2024 annual budget on Tuesday, December 12, 2023 at 7:30 PM at the Richland Fire House, Richland, NJ. Roll Call: L. Burshtin - Yes, R. Knapp - Yes, Levari, Jr. - Absent, Levari III - Absent, Micheletti - Yes. Motion was approved. The Secretary will arrange for publication of a legal notice of public hearing.

The Secretary announced that the NJ Department of Community Affairs had announced a 2023 American Rescue Plan Firefighter Grant program, for grants up to \$75,000 for Safety equipment, with applications due December 8. The Commissioners were in agreement to apply for the maximum amount of \$75,000 for replacement of the remaining 4500 psi SCBA equipment which will need to be obtained in the next year.

<u>Resolution 2023-22</u>: (American Rescue Plan Firefighter Grant) - A motion was made by Randall Knapp and seconded by Mary Ann Micheletti to authorize the Fire District to submit to the NJ Department of Community Affairs an American Rescue Plan Firefighter Grant application for \$75,000 for acquisition of replacement SCBA apparatus, and that the Chairman and Secretary are authorized to execute all required documents. Roll Call: L. Burshtin - Yes, R. Knapp- Yes, Levari, Jr. - Absent, Levari III - Absent, Micheletti - Yes. Motion was approved.

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Upon review of the budget, there is enough funds to purchase an additionial SCBA to continue working towards replacing the SCBA's expiring next year. The following Resolution was made:

<u>Resolution 2023-23:</u> (One Scott X3 Pro SCBA) - A motion was made by Randall Knapp and seconded by Lynn Burshtin to award a purchase to DiVal Safety Equipment in accordance with their proposal 4T86700 for one Scott X3 Pro SCBA, two 4,500 psi 45 minute carbon fiber air cylinders, and one AV3000 HT medium face piece, at a total cost not to exceed \$8,900.00 reflecting the NJ State Contract price and including a customer loyalty discount.
